As with Jesus in the Gospel, people flocked to St. Brigid because she spoke with authority, and carried her words into actions. Her kindness to the poor and needy is legendary. She often shared scarce resources and scarce commodities, much to the annoyance of those in charge. In her own lifetime she was regarded as a saint.
