- Monday 3rd is also the Feast of St. Ansgar, born in France, Bishop of Hamburg, died 865.
 Wednesday 5th, St. Agatha, martyred in Sicily, third century.

Thursday 6th, the Japanese Martyrs, St. Paul Miki and Companions, martyred at Nagasaki, 1597.

Thursday 7th, St. Mel, Founder and First Bishop of Ardagh. Patron of the Diocese.

Friday 8th, St. Jerome Emiliani. After a military career he founded a congregation for the care of orphans and the poor, died 1537.

Friday 8th, St. Josephine Bakhita, 1868 - 1947, thought to be the only canonised saint from Sudan.
