- ✤ Monday 4th is the Feast of St. Caisimir, 1458-1484, born in Krakow, son of the king of Poland. He refused to become engaged in warfare and declined a politically advantageous proposal of marriage with the emperor's daughter. He died of tuberculosis at the age of 26 and was canonised in 1521. A patron saint of Poland and Lithuania. Tuesday 5th, St. Kieran, first Bishop of Ossory (Kilkenny).

Wednesday 6th, St. Colette, 1381-1447, a French nun who undertook reform of the Poor Clares.

Thursday 7th, St. Perpetua, a young upper-class married woman, martyred at Carthage, (Tunisia), in 203.

Thursday 7th, St. Felecity, a slave girl also martyred at Carthage in 203.

Friday 8th, St. John of God, 1495-1550, native of Portugal; patron saint of nurses.

Friday 8th, St. Senan, Kilrush, Co. Clare, founded a monastery on Scattery Island, anamchara (soul-mate) of St. Ciaran and St. Brendan, died 544.

Saturday 9th, St. Frances of Rome, 1384-1440, a married woman, outstanding in her devotion to the needy.
