

## THE EIGHTEENTH SUNDAY IN ORDINARY TIME 4th August, 2013



We come into this world with nothing and leave with nothing. Our thoughts should be on 'heavenly things'. Our goal, to be 'rich in the sight of God'. What treasures are important to us?

- ✤ Mass on Saturday (Vigil), 8.00 p.m.; Sunday, 10.30 a.m.; Monday, 8.00 p.m.; Tuesday, Wednesday, Thursday and Friday, 9.30 a.m.
- ★ Mass for the Intentions of the People of the Parish, Missa pro Populo, on Sunday 4th, at 10.30 a.m.
- ✤ Sunday 4th is the Feast of St. John Mary Vianney, 1786-1859, Curé de Ars, renowned confessor and spiritual healer.

Monday 5th, the Dedication of the Basilica of St. Mary Major in Rome. It is the first church in the West named in honour of the Mother of God.

Tuesday 6th is The Feast of The Transfiguration of the Lord, a glimpse of his Resurrection glory.

Wednesday 7th, St. Sixtus II, Pope, martyred with companions in 258.

Wednesday 7th, St. Cajetan, 1480-1547, promoted renewal of sacramental life in the Church.

Thursday 8th, St. Dominic, 1170-1221, a Spaniard who founded the Dominicans (Order of Preachers) to counteract heresy.

Friday 9th, St. Teresa Benedict of the Cross (Edith Stein), a Patroness of Europe, born 1891 into a Jewish family in Poland, she became a Catholic and later a Carmelite nun, martyred in the gas chamber at Auschwitz, 9th August, 1942.

Friday 9th, St. Nathy, native of Co. Sligo, appointed Bishop of Achonry by St. Finian in 552.

Friday 9th, St. Felim, 6th century, patron of the diocese of Kilmore.

Saturday 10th, St. Lawrence, seen as the cheerful giver since he was one of the seven deacons of the Roman Church in charge of the material needs of the faithful, martyred in Rome 258.
