5th/6th January, 2013

The Epiphany turns a Jewish feast into a worldwide celebration.

Today we celebrate the privilege of being counted, being included,

among the Chosen People to whom the Saviour is revealed.

- Monday 7th is the Feast of St. Raymond of Penyafort, 1175-1275, a brilliant lawyer who joined the Dominicans at 47 and eventually became their Master General. Confessor to the Pope.
 - Wednesday 9th, St. Adrian of Canterbury, African-born abbot of St. Augustine's Monastery at Canterbury, scholar and administrator, adviser and assistant to the Archbishop, he died in 710.
