- ☆ Monday 6th, is the Feast of The Epiphany of the Lord, a holyday of obligation. Mass at 10.30 a.m. and 8.00 p.m. Do make a special effort to attend Mass on this important feast which completes the Christmas season.
- ☆ Tuesday 7th is the Feast of St. Raymond of Peñyafort, 1175-1275, a brilliant lawyer who joined the Dominicans at 47 and eventually became their Master General. Confessor to the Pope.

Thursday 9th, St. Adrian of Canterbury, African-born abbot of St. Augustine's Monastery at Canterbury, scholar and administrator, adviser and assistant to the Archbishop, he died in 710.
