Lady's Well Celebration is on Sunday 3rd September at 12 Noon. No Mass at 10.30am. Reflection:

One day I decided to quit ...I quit my job, my relationship, my spirituality. I went to the woods to have a talk with God.

"God", I said. "Can you give me one good reason not to quit?" His answer surprised me. "Look around", He said. "Do you see the fern and the bamboo?" "Yes", I replied.

"When I planted the fern and the bamboo seeds, I took very good care of them. I gave them light ... I gave them water... the fern quickly grew from the earth - brilliant green foiling ecovering the floor. Yet nothing came from the bamboo seed. But I did not quit on the bamboo. In the second year the fern grew more vibrant and luscious. And again, nothing came from the bamboo seed. I did not out out the bamboo.

"In year three, there was still nothing from the bamboo seed. But I would not quit. The same in year four.

"Then in the fifth year, a tiny sprout emerged from the earth. Compared to the fern, it was small and insignificant. Yet, just six months later, the bamboo had risen to over 100 feet till the lad spent all five years growing roots. These deep roots were necessary to make it strong enough to grow to the such great heights. "Did you know, that all this time you have been strugding, you have actually been growing roots? I would not quit on the bamboo. I will never quit on you."

"Never compare yourself to others," he said. "The bamboo has a different role in the forest to the fern. Yet they both make the forest beautiful." "Your time will come", God said to me. "You will rise high."

I left the forest, realizing that God will never give up on me. And He will never give up on you.
