Reflection

Os Hillman tells the story of a man on horseback, who many years ago, came across a squad of soldiers who were trying to move a heavy piece of timber.

A corporal stood by, giving lordly orders to "Heave!"

But the piece of timber was too heavy for the squad.

"Why don't you help them?" asked the quiet man on the horse, addressing the important corporal.

"Mc? Why, I'm a corporal sir!"

Dismounting, the stranger carefully took his place with the soldiers.

"Now, all together boys - heave!" he said. And the big piece of timber slid into place. The stranger mounted his horse and addressed the copporal. "The next time you have a piece of timber for your men to handle, corporal, send for your commander-in-chief!" The horseman was George Washington, the first American President.

Moral: Leadership isn't about barking orders at others, it's about helping them with the heavy lifting.

You don't engage others by staying aloof from them, you do it by getting amongst them. And respect isn't earned by staying on your high-horse, but from getting down, rolling up your sleeves and getting your hands drive.
