The temptation of Jesus in the desert.

In the second reading St. Paul is writing about Adam and Jesus, about the contrast between them and about the effect each had and has on our lives. We inherited our human nature from Adam. 'Twas from him we inherited our weaknesses, our tendency to sin. All our lives we struggle with this inherited tendency.

But Jesus reversed all that. "If it is certain that through one man's fall so many died, it is even more certain that divine grace, coming through the one man, Jesus Christ, came to so many as an abundant free gift." Our belonging to Adam is by nature. We have no choice in the matter. But our belonging to Christ is by choice. That is why all humankind inherits Adam's fallen human nature, whether we like it or not. But it is only those who choose to belong to Christ that will inherit the blessings that Christ has won for humanity.
