## EXAMINATION OF CONSCIENCE

- 1) I am the Lord your God: you shall not have strange gods before me. Have I treated people, events, or things as more important than God?
- 2) You shall not take the name of the Lord your God in vain. Have my words, actively or passively, put down God ... or people?
- 3) Remember to keep holy the Lord's Day. Do I go to Mass every Sunday (or Saturday Vigil) and on Holy Days of Obligation (Jan. 6th; St. Patrick's Day; Aug. 15th; Nov. 1; Dec. 8? Do I avoid, when possible - work that impedes worship of God ... joy for the Lord's Day, and proper relaxation of mind and body? Do I look for ways to spend time with family or in service on Sunday?
- 4) Honour your father and your mother. Do I show my parents due respect? Do I seek to maintain good communication with my parents where possible? Do I respect the elderly?
- 5) You shall not kill. Have I harmed another through physical, verbal, or emotional means, including gossip or manipulation of any kind?
- 6) You shall not commit adultery. Have I respected the physical and sexual dignity of others and of myself?
- 7) You shall not steal. Have I taken or wasted time or resources that belonged to another?
- 8) You shall not bear false witness against your neighbour. Have I gossiped, told lies, or embellished stories at the expense of another?
- 9) You shall not covet your neighbour's spouse. Have I honoured my spouse with my full affection and exclusive love?
- 10) You shall not covet your neighbour's goods. Am I content with my own means and needs, or do I compare myself to others unnecessarily?
