FEAST OF THE BAPTISM OF THE LORD 11th January, 2015

Baptism is much more than getting our names in the register. Baptism is a moment of new life. It's a moment of choice. We choose what we accept and believe, we decide what we wish reject. We spend our lives catching up with our beginning, struggling to fulfil the promises made on our behalf. What started at our Christening needs to be validated by our personal decisions. We haven't left our Baptism behind us. It faces us each day as God's expectation of us.

- ▼ Tuesday 13th is the Feast of St. Hilary, 315-367, elected bishop of his native city of Poitiers in France, exiled by the Emperor because of his relentless opposition to the Arian heresy which denied the divinity of Christ.

Wednesday 14th, St. Felix of Nola, Italian priest, fortured under the Emperor Decius, credited with many conversions, died 260.

Thursday 15th, St. Ita. Young people, male and female came to her monastery at Killeedy, Co. Limerick, hence her title, "Foster Mother of the saints of Ireland", she died in 570.

Friday 16th, St. Fursa, born in Ireland, became one of the great monastic missionaries with foundations in East Anglia and in France where he died about 650.

Saturday 17th, St. Anthony, "Father of Christian monks", lived a life of solitude but also guided others, died 570.

☼ Ordinary Time begins on Monday 12th. This is the term used to describe periods in the Church year which do not feature a liturgical season. It is denoted by the colour green and runs from the Feast of the Baptism of the Lord to the beginning of Lent and from Pentecost to Advent.
