National Heritage Week event at Newtowncashel - Sat Aug 17th 2pm & 4pm

Visit this fantastic community park with Matthew Parkes, Geological Curator in the Natural History Museum, Dublin to discover limestone rock, how it was extracted and what it was used for - including the most famous building in the county, St. Mel's Cathedral.
