- ✠ **Monday 13th** is the Feast of St. Edward the Confessor, King of England, recognized for his almsgiving, died 1066.
Tuesday 14th, Callistus, became Pope in 217, martyred 222.
Wednesday 15th, St. Teresa of Avila, Spain, 1515-1582, Carmelite, undertook reform of the Carmelite Order, renowned spiritual writer.
Thursday 16th, St. Gerard Majella, Redemptorist Brother, 1726-1755, died at 29, patron of expectant mothers.
Thursday 16th, St. Margaret Mary Alacoque, 1647-1690, revived devotion to the Sacred Heart.
Thursday 16th, St. Gall, a monk of Bangor, set out with St. Columbanus for the continent, preached in France and Switzerland, died in 624.
Wednesday 16th, St. Hedwig, 1174-1243, wife of the Duke of Silesia and mother of seven children, celebrated for her devotion and kindness.
Friday 17th, St. Ignatius of Antioch, Bishop of Antioch, martyred in Rome 107.
Saturday 18th, St. Luke, Evangelist, wrote the third Gospel and the Acts of the Apostles, physician, patron of doctors and surgeons.
