Wednesday 16th, St. Hedwig, 1174-1243, wife of the Duke of Silesia and mother of seven children, celebrated for her devotion and kindness.

Thursday 17th, St. Ignatius of Antioch, Bishop of Antioch, martyred in Rome 107.

Friday 18th, St. Luke, Evangelist, wrote the third Gospel and the Acts of the Apostles, physician, patron of doctors and surgeons.

Saturday 19th, St. Paul of the Cross, 1694-1775, founder of the Passionists.

Saturday 19th, Sts. John de Brébeuf and Isaac Jogues and Companions, Jesuits martyred by Indians in North America, 1647/1648.
