EXAMINATION OF CONSCIENCE

1) I am the Lord your God: you shall not have false gods before me.

Have I treated people, events, or things as more important than God?

2) You shall not take the name of the Lord your God in vain.

Have my words, actively or passively, put down God ... or people?

3) Remember to keep holy the Lord's Day.

Do I go to Mass every Sunday (or Saturday Vigil) and on Holy Days of Obligation?

Do I avoid, when possible - work that impedes worship of God?

4) Honour your father and your mother. Do I show my parents due respect?

Do I seek to maintain good communication with my parents where possible?

Do I respect the elderly?

5) You shall not kill. Have I harmed another in any way, including through gossip or manipulation of any kind?

6) You shall not commit adultery. Have I respected the physical and sexual dignity of others and of myself?

7) You shall not steal. Have I taken or wasted time or resources that belonged to another?

8) You shall not bear false witness against your neighbour. Have I gossiped, told lies, or embellished stories at the expense of another?

9) You shall not covet your neighbour's spouse. Have I honoured my spouse with my full affection and exclusive love?

10) You shall not covet your neighbour's goods. Am I content with my own means and needs, or do I compare myself to others unnecessarily?
