- Sunday 14th is the Feast of St. Davnet, Monaghan. A staff, said to have been hers, has been preserved, and, in the past, was used as a test of truth.
 - Friday 19th, St. Romuald, Italian hermit and abbot, did much to reform the solitary life, died 1027.
 - Saturday 20th, The Irish Martyrs, Irish men and women, cleric, religious and lay, put to death for the Catholic faith between 1579 and 1654.
- ♣ This year is the 14th centenary of St. Columban (Columbanus). Recognised as one of the greatest Irish missionary monks, he founded monasteries in France and Italy. The National Celebrations take place next weekend, Saturday/Sunday, 20th/21st June. St. Columban died at Bobbio, Italy, on 21 November, 615. In Ireland, his feast is celebrated on 23rd November.
