To coincide with the re-opening of the Cathedral the erection of a limestone column in the church grounds, has been completed. The accompanying bronze plaque reads as follows:

The nave of St. Mel's Cathedral, Longford, was flanked by 28 limestone columns quarried at Ballyrevagh, Newtowncashel, in the early 1840s. This base and Ionic capital were salvaged following a fire which destroyed the interior and roof of the building on Christmas Day, 2009.

The column will serve as a reminder of the historic link with the Cathedral. It will also recall the patient skill, craftsmanship and expertise of the stone masons who carved the columns by hand.
