Today's Gospel includes John 3:16, familiar from placards at sporting events. "God loved the world so much that he gave his only Son, so that everyone who believes in him may not be lost but may have eternal life." This is the core message of the Christian faith. God loves us; he sent Jesus to save us from our 'lost' condition and to bring us to that fullness of life that we call salvation.

Mass at 10.30 a.m. and 8.00 p.m. The dates of St. Patrick's life cannot be fixed with certainty but tradition has it that, having spent his youth as a slave in Ireland, he returned as bishop in 432. His mission was eventually very successful making a tremendous number of converts. He died in 461 and is buried at Downpatrick, Co. Down. St. Patrick is venerated as Patron Saint of Ireland.

- Sunday 15th is the Feast of St. Louise de Marillac, 1591-1660, France, widowed at 34, she founded the Daughters of Charity with St. Vincent de Paul, patron saint of social workers.

Wednesday, 18th, St. Cyril of Jerusalem, 315-386, Bishop of Jerusalem, catechist and administrator, exiled in his fight against heresy.

Thursday 19th, St. Joseph, Husband of the Blessed Virgin Mary, venerated as protector of Christian families. Patron of Canada, carpenters and manual workers.

Saturday 21st, St. Enda, a late vocation. His sister Fænche, a nun, turned his thoughts to the religious life. On her urging he went to Aran. He died c 520.
