The Law of Cause and Effect applies to many aspects of the known universe: -A cause has its effect: An effect, its cause.

Ralph Waldo Emerson called this Law - The Law of Laws when it comes to the Spiritual Life. It's powerful. You get back what you put out. It is like a boomerang. You throw it out and it comes back.

If you put a negative out, you will get a negative back. Also, when your output is positive ... you will get a positive back, maybe not straight away, but it will come and especially in the next life.

Shashi Seth, the senior vice-president of Oracle Marketing Cloud, spoke about the concept of reciprocity in business. It's simple. If someone does something for you, you will naturally want to do something for them. He then added that this works for human beings who are classified as "givers," but for people classified as "takers," it has little effect. The good news is that the world has many more givers than takers. Can this be proven? Yes!

Here's his research. When the servers at a restaurant brought the bill to their guests and added a mint, the tip jumps up 3.3%. Two mints and the tip jumps to roughly 20%.

And, it's much bigger than an after-dinner mint. For example, Spotify and Pandora have created streaming music empires by giving away free versions of their product, which is financially supported by advertisers. However, both offer an upgrade to a paid version without advertising. Some of their customers pay, which results in approximately 50% of their revenue.

As long as it has some value to the customer - and that there are "no strings attached" ... the more you give, the more you get.

Moral: If this principle works in the hard-nosed business world ... then it makes even more sense in the Spiritual One.

Jesus in today's Gospel is not talking about our talents in the modern sense of that word. Scripture scholars say that its original meaning refers to the mercy/love that God gives to you and me throughout our lifetime.

The parable means ... The more love we give to God while still on this earth the more we'll get ... when we come before Him at the Judgment Day. Likewise -The less we give - the less we'll get! So, while there's still time ... let us make that precious effort to give to Our Maker that which will be returned to us with interest when we need it most - on leaving this earth. What is this effort God wants? The Saints tell us ... there are 2 things: 1) Conversion of life through Prayer, Mass and Penance ... and 2) Kindness to others.
