Sunday 17th, The Seven Founders of the Servite Order; seven prominent citizens of Florence who, in 1233, set themselves up as hermits outside the city. From this beginning developed the Servite Order. The Seven Founders were canonised in 1888.

Thursday 21st, St. Peter Damian, 1007-1072, Italian Cardinal, one of the greatest reformers of the Middle Ages.

Friday 22nd, The Chair of St. Peter, a celebration of St. Peter as Bishop of Rome, and Christ's choice of Peter for the service of the whole Church.

Saturday 23rd, St. Polycarp, a disciple of St. John the Evangelist, bishop of Smyrna in Turkey, martyred 155.
