Reflection:

A number of years ago in California, a 14yr old girl called Donna Ashlok developed a life threatening heart ailment and needed a heart transplant urgently to survive. Her 15 year old neighbour Felipe Gorza had a deep crush on her but she had never shown any interest in him.

One day Felipe said to his mother, with great joy and cheerfulness, "When I die ... I

want to give her my heart."

No-one understood or paid any heed to what he said. Apparently, he had a premonition of his death, for less than a week later, a blood vessel

burst in his brain and he died. Felipe's heart was transplanted immediately to the girl he loved from a distance and knew he would never have.

Today, we have a concrete example of a heart being left behind," the Rev. Thomas Cargo said in his sermon for Felipe Garza Jr. at Sacred Heart Catholic Church, Patter-

son, California. - (New York Times).

"In 1986, shortly after Felipe's death, the Patterson City Council renamed by resolution Walnut Acres Park to Felipe A. Garza Jr. Memorial Park. The named the park in the boy's honour.

Moral: Her whole life was changed ... for, like most people, she thought she knew what love was about: attraction to someone because they are good looking or tall or successful etc. Felipe had none of these things. There were those who had often said, "I love you" or "I'll give you my heart" when she was well ... Felipe did so when she needed it most.

Every time we come to Holy Communion, Jesus offers to do likewise for us. Only He offers a Heart that will never stop again ... eternally. Similarly, I must be prepared to let go of the old damaged one. Lent is one more chance on the short circle of time to take Him up on that. But we must remember that the old one has to go · Pride, Anger, Lust, Laziness, Greed, Gluttony, Envy/Jealousy, Cowardice and Folly, Prayer, Fasting and Almsgiving are the only ways to do that - St. John of the Cross.

How about going to Mass during the weekdays ... 10 minutes Adoration on Wednesdays or Friday ... or even a decade of the Rosary every day ... there's only 40 days left!
