THE FIFTH SUNDAY OF EASTER 17th/18th May, 2014



Despite all its facilities and benefits the world in which we live gives rise to many anxieties - health issues, exams, unemployment, emigration. People seek answers and solutions from sources of all kinds. But Jesus points out that he is the only answer, the only

solution. "I am the Way, the Truth and the Life. No one can come to the Father except through me." If we want to reach the goal of our lives he is the one from whom we should take our direction and guidance. We're more familiar with today's Gospel in the context of funeral Masses. It's one of the most consoling and reassuring Gospel readings.

- Mass for The Intentions of the People of the Parish, Missa pro Populo, on Monday 19th, at 8.00 p.m.
- Sunday 18th is the Feast of St. John I, the first Pope to visit Constantinople, died in prison, 526.
 Monday 19th, the Dedication of St. Mel's Cathedral, foundation stone laid, Tuesday, 19th May, 1840; opened for divine worship, 24th September, 1856; solemn consecration, Friday, 19th May, 1893, destroyed by fire, Friday, 25th December, 2009.

Tuesday 20th, St. Bernardine of Siena, 1380-1444, Franciscan, preached in Italy promoting devotion to the Holy Name of Jesus.

Wednesday 21st, St. Christopher Magallánes and Companions, 1869-1927, a Mexican priest who resisted the anti-Church government and, with 24 companions, was martyred in 1927.

Thursday 22nd, St. Rita, born in Italy,1386. On the death of her abusive husband she was admitted to the monastery of the Augustinian Nuns at Casica. She spent her time in prayer, charity and devotion to Our Lord's Passion, and died of tuberculosis on 22nd May, 1457. She is a patron of abuse victims.

Saturday 24th is celebrated in Australia as the Feast of Our Lady Help of Christians.
