Wednesday 23rd, St. John of Capistrano, 1386-1456, studied civil and canon law and joined the Franciscans, contracted fever in a battle at Belgrade and died there, patron of jurists and military chaplains.

Thursday 24th, St. Anthony Mary Claret, 1807-1870, founded the Claretians in Spain; became Archbishop of Santiago, Cuba; returned as chaplain to the Queen of Spain, died as an exile in France.

Friday 25th, Blessed Thaddeus McCarthy, 1455-1492, bishop of Ross, Cork and Cloyne who died in Italy after a pilgrimage to Rome.
