## THE FIFTH SUNDAY OF LENT 22nd March, 2015

Jesus said, "Unless a wheat grain falls on the ground and dies, it remains only a single grain; but if it dies, it yields a rich harvest." It's a simple analogy, easily understood. Jesus is near the high point, the goal of his life. Along the way there have been hints and pointers. Now things shift up a gear with predictions that will reach their climax in the scenes of the long Gospel that we will hear next Sunday.

- Mass on Saturday (Vigil), 8.00 p.m.; Sunday, 10.30 a.m.; Tuesday, Wednesday and Thursday, 7.00 a.m.; Friday, 8.00 p.m.
- Mass for the Intentions of the People of the Parish, on Tuesday 24th, at 7.00 a.m.
- Monday 23rd is the Feast of St. Turibius of Mongrovejo, 1538-1606. Archbishop of Lima, Peru. He built up the Church in that country. Patron of Peru and Latin American bishops. Tuesday 24th, St. Macartan, first bishop of Clogher Diocese.
   Wednesday 25th, The Annunciation of the Lord; Giving her consent to God's Word, Mary is to become the mother of Jesus.
- ✤ Sunday next is Palm Sunday, the commencement of Holy Week. Palms will be blessed at the beginning of Mass on Saturday and Sunday.
- ✿ Confessions, in preparation for the Easter Triduum, on Monday week, 30th, at 7.00 p.m., and in St. Mary's Church, Lanesboro, on Wednesday, 1st April, at 7.30 p.m. Visiting confessors will attend in both instances. Those who wish to go to Confession for Easter are urged to avail of these opportunities.
- ✤ Lenten Masses. During Lent, Mass is celebrated at 7.00 a.m. on Tuesdays, Wednesdays and Thursdays. Everyone welcome.
- ✤ First Friday. The Holy Communion calls to the sick and housebound, associated with the First Friday, will be made on Wednesday and Thursday of this week. Neighbours and carers are asked to notify those who may not be aware of the changed arrangement.
