Friday 27th, **The Most Sacred Heart of Jesus**, a celebration of the immense love of God for us, revealed in the life, death and resurrection of Jesus Christ.

Friday 27th, St. Cyril of Alexandria, 370-444, Patriarch of Alexandria, defended the teaching that Mary is the Mother of God.

Saturday 28th, The Immaculate Heart of Mary. This feast celebrates Mary's instinctive, maternal relationship with her Son in his work of salvation.

Saturday 28th, St. Irenæus, 130-200, martyr, Bishop of Lyons in France, defended the faith against the Gnostics who proclaimed the dominance of evil.

Sunday 29th June, is the Feast of **Saints Peter and Paul, Apostles**. On the day traditionally observed in pagan Rome as its foundation day by Romulus and Remus we celebrate the feast of the twin founders of the Church in Rome. St. Peter died by crucifixion and St. Paul, a Roman citizen, was beheaded between 64 and 67.
