 - Sunday 23rd, St. Clement I, Pope from 88 to 97, the fourth bishop of Rome, one of the fathers of the early church.

Monday 24th, St. Colman, 530 – 606, founder and patron of the Diocese of Cloyne and patron of its Cathedral in Cobh.

Monday 24th, The Vietnamese Martyrs, 96 natives and 21 missionaries martyred in Vietnam in the 17th, 18th and 19th centuries.

Tuesday 25th, St. Catherine of Alexandria, beheaded at Alexandria in 310, her body is venerated in the Monastery at Mount Sinai.

Wednesday 26th, St. Leonard, 1676-1751, Franciscan preacher in Italy, promoted the devotion of the Stations of the Cross.

Thursday 27th, St. Fergal, Abbot of Aghaboe, Co. Laois, ministered in France and Bavaria, died 784.

Friday 28th, St. Catherine Labouré, 1806-1876, a sister of the Daughters of Charity and a visionary. As a result of one of her visions she initiated the devotion of the "Miraculous Medal".
