

- ✤ Tuesday 26th is the Feast of St. Alexander, who became Bishop of Alexandria, Egypt, in 312. He challenged the Arian heresy which denied the divinity and sinlessness of Christ. The Emperor Constantine sided with Alexander at the Council of Nicea in 325 and Arianism was officially condemned. He died the following year, 326.
