## TRINITY SUNDAY

26th May, 2013



The feast of the Blessed Trinity gives us insights into God's role in our lives and in our world. They are the perfect team. The feast prompts us to be more aware of our own role in the Christian team. It's a team in which no one has a monopoly on the one hand, and no one is just a spectator either.

- Mass on Saturday (Vigil), 8.00 p.m.; Sunday, 10.30 a.m.; Monday and Friday, 8.00 p.m.; Tuesday and Thursday, 9.30 a.m.;
- Mass for the Intentions of the People of the Parish, *Missa pro Populo*, on Tuesday 28th, at 8.00 p.m.
- Sunday 26th is the Feast of St. Philip Neri, 1515-1607, ordained priest in Rome at 46, worked for the spiritual improvement of the Romans, renowned for his cheerfulness.

  Monday 27th, St. Augustine of Canterbury, sent by Pope Gregory the Great to preach to the people of England; arrived in Kent in 597, died 604.
  - Thursday 30th, St. Joan of Arc, burned at the stake in Rouen, France, in her late teens, patroness of soldiers and of France.
  - Friday 31st, **The Visitation of the Blessed Virgin Mary.** This feast commemorates May's visit to her cousin St. Elizabeth.
  - Saturday, 1st June, St. Justin, born in the Holy Land, settled in Rome where he opened a school, martyred 165.
