- ✘ **Mass** on Saturday (Vigil), 8.00 p.m.; Sunday, 10.30 a.m.; Tuesday and Wednesday, 9.30 a.m.
- ✘ Friday, 1st November, is the **Feast of All Saints**, a holyday of obligation. Mass at 10.30 a.m. and 8.00 p.m.
- ✘ Saturday 2nd, is the Commemoration of All the Faithful Departed, the **Feast of All Souls**. Mass at 9.30 a.m. and 8.00 p.m.
- ✘ **Confessions** on Friday at 11.10 a.m. and 8.40 p.m.; on Saturday at 10.00 a.m. and 8.40 p.m. (after Mass).
- ✘ Mass for the **Intentions of the People of the Parish**, on Tuesday 29th, at 9.30 a.m.
- ✘ Sunday 27th is the Feast of St. Otteran, a companion of St. Colmcille, whom he accompanied to Iona, patron of Waterford City and Diocese.
Monday 28th, Saints Simon and Jude, Apostles; Simon, known as the Zealot, was born in Cana; Jude, also known as Thaddeus, is patron saint of hopeless causes.
Tuesday 29th, St. Colman, 7th century, native and patron of Kilmacduagh, Co. Galway, where he founded a church in addition to two on Inis Mór, Aran Islands.
- ✘ **Teen Mass**. Teenagers are the main participants in this Sunday's Mass. A final rehearsal will be held in Church at 9.45 a.m. (before Mass). All young people are invited.
- ✘ **"Do This in Memory"**. On Sunday next, 3rd November, the Thirty-First Sunday in Ordinary Time, the First Communion children and their parents are the principal participants in the liturgy. The children will have their Rosary beads blessed during the Mass.

~~~~~ THE HOLY SOULS – INDULGENCES ~~~~~

From 12 noon on 1st November until midnight on 2nd November, all who have been to Confession, received Holy Communion and prayed for the Pope's intentions (one Our Father and Hail Mary or any other prayer of one's choice) can gain one plenary indulgence by visiting a church or oratory, and there reciting one Our Father and the Apostles' Creed. This indulgence is applicable only to the Departed. Confession may be made any time within the week preceding or the week following 1st November. Holy Communion may be received on any day from 1st to 8th November. For every other visit to a church during this time a partial indulgence may be gained for the same intention.

Those who visit a cemetery and pray for the dead may gain a plenary indulgence applicable only to the Holy Souls on the usual conditions once per day from 1st to 8th November. The conditions mentioned above also apply.

- ✘ **Adoration of the Blessed Sacrament**. At its recent meeting the Parish Pastoral Council decided that the commencement and conclusion times for Adoration on Wednesdays be adjusted to take account of declining participation. **Adoration will begin at 4.00 p.m. and finish at 8.00 p.m.** There are vacancies for several more participants.
- ✘ Friday is the **First Friday** of November. The Holy Communion calls to the sick and housebound will be made on Wednesday and Thursday (Friday's calls on Wednesday). Neighbours and carers are asked to inform the people concerned.
