Wednesday 3rd, St. Thomas, Apostle, said to have preached the Gospel in India where he suffered martyrdom.

Thursday 4th, St. Elizabeth of Portugal, 1271-1336, unhappily married to the King of Portugal, she persevered in prayer and good works. When her husband died she chose a life of poverty. She is invoked in time of war.

Friday 5th, St. Anthony Mary Zaccaria, 1502-1539, a medical doctor before becoming a priest in Milan.

Saturday 6th, St. Maria Goretti, 1890-1902, Italy, stabbed to death at the age of twelve, while defending her virtue.

Saturday 6th, St. Monnine of Killeavy, one of Ireland's earliest women saints, founded a community at Sliabh Gullion, Co. Armagh, died 517 or 518.
