## TWENTY SECOND SUNDAY IN ORDINARY TIME 31st August, 2014

"The Son of Man will reward each one according to his behaviour.

- ₩ Mass on Monday and Friday, 8.00 p.m.; Tuesday and Thursday, 9.30 a.m.
- ► Sunday 31st is the Feast of St. Aidan of Lindisfarne, of Irish descent and a monk of Iona. At the invitation of King Oswald he preached to the people of Northumbria with much success and founded his monastery on the Isle of Lindisfarne. He died on 31st August, 651.

**We**dnesday 3rd, St. Gregory the Great, 540-604, a Roman noble and Prefect of the City before becoming a monk; elected Pope in 590, he established a pattern for the papacy in years to come and originated Gregorian chant. It was he who sent St. Augustine of Canterbury on mission to England.

Thursday 4th, St. Mac Nissi, Down and Connor. Tradition has it that he was baptised by St. Patrick. He founded a hermitage in the district of Connor and was later ordained bishop. He died early in the 6th century.

Friday 5th, Blessed Teresa of Calcutta (Mother Teresa). Born in Macedonia, 26 August, 1910. At 18 she joined the Loreto Sisters in Dublin. In Calcutta she sought out "the unwanted, the unloved, the uncared for". There, in 1950, she founded the Missionaries of Charity, a congregation which eventually spread to 123 countries. Mother Teresa died in Calcutta on 5th September, 1997, aged 87 years. She was beatified by Pope John Paul II on 19th October, 2003.
